Wednesday

June 1st 1870

Bain, Kate, Mark, Amy, and I picked over
some apples.

Thursday

June 2nd 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield, Amy
rode with him this afternoon and came
home through Hinshalls run, and found some
sheep. Mark rode twice out looking for bark;
once on Bonnie Blue on Lucy. Edwin went
spooning. This is my seventeenth birthday!
Mama gave me a nice bodice, this journal and
other little things, Amy a collar and broach; and
Papa a bag of pens. Amy and I rode over
to Horrell this morning.

Friday

June 3rd 1870

Fine. Papa rode once to Mayfield.
Mark has been riding all day. Edwin
went to the saltworks. Amy and I rode
up to Mr. Dore's and brought back Miss
Lucy. The mason has come back. Our
first purchases (A5, A4, & mine) have come

Saturday

June 4th 1870

Fine sharp shower. Papa was leading the cart for the Doctor to kick up stones before the plough in the front field; rode to Mayfield. Mark rode Gary to Mayfield, then home to bring home Judy to be broken in. Edwin has been shooting.

Monday

June 6th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield, & to Head. Mark rode Gary out in the sun. Mama and Kate started for Swansea with Edwin on B. Amy rode to Head thrashing with them but Dot fell just there & broke the gig so they had to return. Mark went possumming.

Tuesday

June 7th 1870

Fine. Papa and I rode to Mayfield this afternoon, I also rode to Llany. Mama and Kate have started for Melbourne. Edwin has ridden B. with them to open gates and bring back Dot where they take the coach. Amy rode L. to Picnic Valley with them. Dot has been washing the flight off apple trees (young ones); rode out to one of the bedding hills.

Wednesday

June 8th 1870

Fine. Papa and I rode to Mayfield. He stayed in the front field this morning. Mark rode Gary out in the sun; has gone possumming. Amy went down on the beach.

Thursday

June 9th 1870

Fine. Cold wind. Papa and Miss Dennis have gone to Swansea. Mark has been hunting; took Gary out to the bedding hills. I rode him to Mayfield beach. Amy went down on our beaches.

Friday

June 10th 1870

Fine but cold. Papa has returned with Mr. William Lyne. Mark rode Gary out in the sun. Amy went down on the beaches.

Saturday

June 11th 1870

Rain. Mr. H. J. Lyne returned after breakfast. Mark nips L. in the barn thrashing. Amy and I rode about a little this evening.

Monday

June 13rd 1870

Been fine - frost. Papa rode to Mayfield
Mark rode Harry to the Saltworks, and
Mayfield; then looking for shells at the
Point, and Henshaw run. Edwin has
come home and brought Dot back. Henshaw
and Hale got on all right. No Mayflower com-

Tuesday

June 14th 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield. I rode with
him, then went down on the beach came
back after dinner. Amy went down on one
when I came home. Mark has lightning
again instead of Fliz he went hunting took
Harry round the balding hills. Tom Pike came

Wednesday

June 15th 1870

Fine - sharp frost. Papa rode to Mayfield. Amy
rode B. to that beach for shells. Mark got up
early rode Harry out on the balding hills, ate the
breakfast pole him to Mayfield with two cows, but
Edwin and Mark have gone sparrowing in up to post James Dodge had Dot f. go to Swanser
has Dot. The Williams bought me a jackass

Thursday

June 16th 1870

Sharp frost. Papa and I rode to Mayfield, and
brought home two cows. Amy rode Dot to Hotel.
Edwin ringed another jackass. Mark commenced
rowing the long paddleboat. Amy walked down on
the beach.

Friday

June 17th 1870

Fine. Papa, Mark, and I rode to Mayfield, and
gathered the lambs, then I went down to Jenkins
Island, and stayed picking shells till four o'clock.
Amy rode S. there too this afternoon. Edwin shot a
cow.

Saturday

June 18th 1870

Rained last night and this morning. Papa rode
home to Mayfield. Mark rode out Jenkins
Island, I rode down on the beach and up to the
wood. Amy rode to Mayfield beaches; she has
a young rabbit for a pet.

Monday

June 19th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield.
Mark rode B. there twice for horses; then went
out with Edwin for some sheep. Amy went
up to post James Dodge had Dot f. go to Swanser
back. I drove 3 horses to Mayfield this evening

Wednesday
June 21st 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield the second beach, & brought in the home paddock sheep. Amy rode B. to Mayfield beach. Mark and Pettit horse. I too saw the fish come carry to the saddle paddock for sheep, and mark has had Yang at Mayfield. Amy shot a kangaroo behind the school.

Wednesday
June 21st 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Mark and Amy rode there for pigs. Mark got out his gun to the foamy paddock. Elwin has been hunting back to the saltworks, has been out in the finer paddock. Elwin went out this afternoon. I rode round paddocks to Boggs where back Tot Judy & Sion, returned by the same way. Did

Thursday

June 22nd 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield. Mark has had Tot at Mayfield, where he was helping to thresh with the new machine. I rode the to the beaches. Amy has been stuffing half saddle. Elwin went out this afternoon.

Friday
June 23rd 1870

Threatening but dry. Papa rode to Mayfield. I & Sio came to dinner; he has to the Amy rode B. to Mayfield beach. Mark and Pettit horse. I too saw the fish come carry to the saddle paddock for sheep, and mark has had Yang at Mayfield. Amy to Mayfield. Elwin walked round town & the beaches.

Saturday
June 25th 1870

Fine cold wind. Papa rode to Mayfield. Mark rode to Hause for sheep, then took him to the saltworks, has been out in the finer paddock. Elwin went out this afternoon. I rode round paddocks to Boggs where back Tot Judy & Sion, returned by the same way. Did gallining in the morning.

Wednesday

June 27th 1870

Fine. Papa with Harry and round British looking for sheep then I rode home then and got home after dinner. I went out again with Mark. He got up early & went gathering

Mr. Mayson brought Harriet with him yesterday, they went away after dinner.
Helen started on Friday leading Lot, for
Mama, and Kate. The harmonium
has come for the schoolroom.

Tuesday

June 28th 1870

Fine rather. Papa rode B. to Mayfield
then went to Swansea to Pitty and
H. J. Sykes' wedding tomorrow. Mark
rode to Swansea: walked out in the
afternoon. I rode up this side of the creek to
Bird's hut got to sleep. After dinner I went
to Horn's field drove the sheep into the
gathering paddock.

Wednesday

June 29th 1870

Fine. Papa returned. Mark rode
Harry out in the sun. Amy rode Harry
to see Holly who returned home Tuesday.
Holly was shamed this morning at nine
o'clock.

Thursday
June 30th 1870

Gold. Papa rode B. twice to
Mayfield. A gentleman called who
is applying for the superintendence of
police at Swansea. Mark rode Harry
out in the sun; went to Swansea paddock.
Amy went for a ride on Harry to the
tattoo works.

Friday

July 1st 1870

Gold. Papa and I rode Harry walked
to Mayfield and got in the lamb.
Amy went down on the first batch.
Mark is to manage the sheep from
today.

Saturday

July 2nd 1870

Fine. Papa rode B. to Mayfield.
Holly came this morning.

Monday

July 4th 1870

Fine. Papa rode B. twice to Mayfield. Marks

went out gathering. The weather was very
fine. Amy rode down to Mayfield. I did some
gardening. Horses shot & left me foot.

Tuesday

July 5th 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield, saw
the apples picked this morning. Amy
went down on the beach. Mark got
up early, rode away out gathering.

Wednesday

July 6th 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield. Mark
rode B. round the home paddock. Garte
to the saltworks walked out to the farm
paddock. I walked to the magnolia paddock.
Mr. Smith came to dinner. Mama, Garte,
and Edwin came home about 11 o'clock, she
did not go to Melbourne.

Thursday

July 7th 1870

Fine. Papa rode first to Mayfield, Mark
rode Gary, then Dot out in the am. Garte, Amy,
and I walked up to the bridge down along
the creek to the old open house. Mama, Edwin
home from Geneva. And the day over.

Friday

July 8th 1870

Fine. Papa rode Dot to Mayfield.
Mark and Amy rode out in the back
sun but did not get any. Mr. Scott's
out this morning. Marks Plover went out
shooting. This is my house keeping week.
The three of us are to be in succession.

Saturday

July 9th 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield once.
Garte and Amy walked to Mayfield.
Mark rode B. in the home paddock.
Dot to Mayfield. Mr. Mitchellmore called.

Sunday

July 11th 1870

Fine. Papa went to Mayfield twice.
Mark walked out in the pm. Edwin to
Mayfield. Garte, Amy, and I rode to Hebron.
All came to talk to Mama. Edwin and
I walked up to the bridge down along
the creek to the old open house. Mama, Edwin
yesterday, and I played it. Mr. Mayton
went after breakfast.

Tuesday

July 12th 1870

Bien fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Mark rode away out in the sun. Kate and I went up and had a practice on the harmonium.

Wednesday

July 13th 1870

Bien fine. Papa rode to Mayfield this. Mark got up early rode & out in the sun. Amy rode Sat to the Salthorpe, and then Marry just went to Lays. Kate and I went up to the School to practise on the harmonium. Edwin went to the Salthorpe saw our new boat it is 22 ft long. Marks & James Dingle went to the Middle paddock.

Thursday

July 14th 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield, and to the Middle paddock. Edwin and Mark went up to Little Swanton and bought home our boat "The Nuttelus". Kate and I ran down for a row just before tea. We three went and practised with the

people. Mr Buckley and Mr. came this afternoon. Twenty pigs were killed today.

Friday

July 15th 1870

Bien fine. Papa rode to Mayfield. Amy & I set out for the home paddock shells. Edwin went shooting. Mark has been out sheep hunting, found twenty. Kate, Amy, and helped about the land. I & I had a row. into Miss Guttels called.

Saturday

July 16th 1870

Bien fine. Papa, Mark, and I rode to Mayfield, gathered the lambs. Amy, Mark, and I went in the boat. Kate practised on the harmonium. Amy drove Marry & went for a ride.

Sunday

July 18th 1870

Rain. Edwin and Mark went out in the sea to fish but soon returned.

Tuesday

July 19th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. I went with him, hunting at the back of Mayfield. Amy rode Dot to the Back. Amy has been out at the Penny Paddock. Kate went out also. Kate and I rode down on the beach, then went for a row.

Wednesday

July 20th 1870

Showers. Papa, Kate, and I rode to Mayfield. A. & I drove in the horses, put faithful in the yard. Elwin and Kate have been mucking the Penny Paddock. Amy rode over to Hotels.

Thursday

July 21st 1870

Fine, too, showers. Papa rode to Mayfield and Mr. Hinshalls sun. Elwin and Kate have been measuring the Penny Paddock.

Kate, Amy, and I rowed Hema up to the gardens. I rode B. for vegetables. I went up to practise.

Friday

July 22nd 1870

Fine showers. Papa, and I rode to the middle paddock, then took a cow and calf to Mayfield. Kate rode to the Hill, then the school to practise. I rode up there also. Kate rode Garry to the sawworks for sheep, took him back on B. He has been out in the river paddocks with James Dodge driving cattle, and Edwin. Old fish brought oysters. Amy rode Lion to Bogus.

Saturday

July 23rd 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield. I rode home also met Amy at Mr. Hinshalls, so we went over to Hobley and drove from Dot and Judy Park and James Dodge took iron and a plough to the Penny Paddock. Elwin will measure it. Kate went to practise. I did on my way to ride.

Monday

July 24th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Amy and I rode there this morning after had got vegetables. To Mayson went away. Elwin, Kate, and James Dodge have been

Amy took the paddles down in the boat
for a short time.

Tuesday

July 26th 1870

Been fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield.
Amy and I rode there and saw sufficient
paddock. Edwin gathered his own at the
Feiney paddock. Mark gathered the home
paddock, then we rode out in the back
run. I went to practise first, then Kate
went. Kate washed flowers on the beach.

Wednesday

July 17th 1870

Sun. rainy. Papa rode to Mayfield.
Kate, Amy, and I rode Dot's B., and
Lion. to the Fishmans. Mark rode
Amy into the middle paddock for sheep
then to the saltworks for sheep, roof that
Houses after being dressed. Edwin
and James Dodge have been out in
the Feiney paddocks.

Thursday

July 28th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Mark
has had nothing ploughing in the Feiney paddock.

Edwin and James Dodge have been
measuring it. Amy's Kangaroo got away.
She, and I rode to Mayfield. Kate, Amy,
and I visited the school, then had the
practise.

Friday

July 29th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield.
Amy rode there for the measuring chain
and then took them to the Feiney paddock
for Edwin, Mark, and James D. I drove
James out there to see the first clearing
three quarters of an acre. Kate went
to practise.

Saturday

July 30th 1870

All day. Clark rode Dot out hunting.
Kate went up to see Dobson whistling
practice. Amy and I rode down on the
beach to the creek; I then went to practise.

Monday

August 1st 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Amy
has had nothing ploughing in the Feiney paddock.

I rode down on the beach. Kate walked for vegetables to see Dobson and on the beach. Mr. Buckley had a daughter last Saturday. Edwin Mark, and James Dodge have been at the Ferney paddock.

Tuesday

August 2nd 1870

Fine. Papa rode ^{to} Mayfield. Amy and I rode Dot, and Gary to that beach. Edwin Mark, and James Dodge have been planting apple and pear trees in the Ferney paddock. Kate walked down our beaches. Dot up to see Dobson, and to practice. Papa rode out to the ^{old} paddock. 10 pigs killed.

Wednesday

August 5th 1870

Fine. Papa rode B. To Mayfield the Ferney paddock for sheep. I went to practice twice to the first beach. Amy rode to the Creek twice. Mark rode Gary out in the middle run. Edwin and James Dodge have been in the Ferney paddock. Kate has given Brownie to Amy. She went to see Dobson.

Thursday

August 4th 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield, and middle paddock. Kate went to the practice park has been looking for sheep on fort Bruno, and James Dodge have been mowing the Ferney paddock. Amy and I rode Gary and Amy over to Howell's with his horses. Amy rode Leon on the beach.

Friday

August 5th 1870

Fine. Hard frost. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Edwin and James Dodge have been at the Ferney paddock. Mark rode Gary to Mayfield. I went to practice and hauled out the boat. Kate went down on the beach and did some gardening. Amy rode Gary about home. Gary has been building an aviary. I named this afternoon, and yesterday.

Saturday

August 6th 1870

Monday. Papa stayed at home because they were threshing. Mark walked out in the sun. Edwin and James Dodge have been at the Jenny Field. Amy rode B. a little. I finished an egg cosy for Betty Lyne's wedding present and did some gardening. Late went to see Dolson and practice.

Tuesday

August 7th 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield. I rode Harry to the saltworks. Mayfield has been at the Jenny Field and then up to practice. Edwin has been in the Jenny Field. Mark has been there and out in the sun. Amy has been riding Harry a little. Mr. Hulizon went away this morning.

Wednesday

August 8th 1870

Fine. Papa, Mark and I went to

Mayfield and gathered the lambs. Then got in the horses, and as Mark was walking, he and Guy led Littleful home. Amy rode us afterwards. Mark went over the creek in the boat, got dots from Horne, rode to Mr. Hinckley's for apples. Late went to practice.

Thursday

August 10th 1870

Fine. Papa rode Harry to Mayfield; and planted seeds in the Creek garden. Amy drove Harry to see Mr. Bulkeley, & to Mayfield. I rode B. about here.

Late I went down on the beach. Edwin has been at the Jenny paddock with Mark to ride Harry in the home paddock for sheep, and to the mangold field.

Friday

August 11th 1870

Fine. Papa stayed at home. Mark helped thresh this morning then went out to the Jenny paddock. That is about the round to home is busy. Late finished a tea cosy for Mr. W. J. Syme went to practice. I rode to Horne.

Friday

August 12th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield.
Mark rode B. out gathering; took two
the sheep again. Edwin, Kate, and Amy
for a sail in the boat. Amy went to the
creek. I went to practice; rode G. with
a saddle down on the beach.

Saturday

August 13th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield.
Amy went down on the beach.
Kate went to practice this morning
in the afternoon. Mark has had time
in his pony paddock, brought home
some sheep. Cut on Faithful for the
first time outside. Edwin and James
D. have been also in the fence paddock.

Sunday

August 15th 1870

Monday. Papa rode to Mayfield.
Mark rode B. out in the morning; some
pruning. I rode Gary to the creek for a walk
to see Bolson and practice. Mr. Shaw has
come. Amy rode to the creek. Kate went to the
beach. Holly called. Dr. Storey dined here.

Tuesday

August 16th 1870

Fine. Papa and Mr. Shaw started
for Rutherford this morning. Edwin and
Mark went hunting. Mr. Shaw also rode
Faithful a little. I rode Dot to Garnet for
little blossoms; practiced on my way home.
Kate and Amy rode Gary and Brownie
to Swansea to call on Mr. H. J. Syre.

Wednesday

August 17th 1870

Windy. Kate and Amy returned
dinner time. Mark and Edwin have
been fencing with Dot. Mr. Shaw rode
a little. Went to the school. Kate went
down on the beach, and to practice.

Thursday

August 18th 1870

Fine. Papa and Mr. Shaw came
dinner time. Mark did some
fencing, looked for sheep. Amy rode B.
to Mayfield back, and out in the rear.
I rode Dot out also. Kate went to the
practice. Mary and Emma went down on the

beach. Mark rode Faithful, with James
on Dot leading him, on the beach.

Friday

August 19th 1870

Been fine. Papa rode Friday to Mayfield
came home late. Edwin went for a walk
Mark has been first in the Fancy paddock
then looked for sheep. Mr. Shaw went
away, and took Amy with him. State
drove Maria for a short drive.

Saturday

August 20th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield.
Mark has been at the Fancy Paddock
State rode Dot to Mayfield. State brought
home a bag of carrots from Mr. Mitchell,
then made some jam with them. State
rode up to practice three times. State
came.

Monday

August 21st 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield

Mr. Mayson came yesterday evening
today. Dr. Story came to dinner because
the Local School board met. Dr. Pilgrim
came. Edwin, took his team in the gig
to Mayfield, but the road had gone.
State, & I went up to Horrells in
the boat. Horrell, Holly, and Jane Anne
got in for a short time. I rode Garry
first to Horrells then Mayfield. Mark
drove sheep with Faithful for the first
time walked to the Fancy Paddock and
sowed some grass seed. got a Kangaroo.

Tuesday

August 23rd 1870

Been fine. Papa, Mark and I rode
Faithful and I to Mayfield, got
in the lamb. I then rode to the school
from 11 to 1 o'clock practiced. State was
this afternoon. Edwin drove to Mayfield
again but was late. I drove Maria
down on the beach and in the bush.
then took James to help clean the gig.

Edwin and Dr Pilgrim went to Horrell's in the "Nautilus".

Wednesday

August 24th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Edwin rowed up to Mark's garden. Mark has been out in the sun. Dr Pilgrim went to see Dobson before he went away. Kate and I rode up to Hanover; got the fisherman to take us up over to Seaford. Had dinner at the Island.

Thursday

August 25th 1870

Fine. Papa rode Dot to Mayfield twice. Jim is lame. Mark rode away out gathering, Faithful this afternoon. Jim went for a row. I rode him to the bill-works, then practiced iron wedge to one. Rode back to Mayfield with Papa and brought home a steam-fat. Kate went to the practice.

Friday

August 26th 1870

Fine. Papa rode Dot down to Mayfield.

Mark & he went to gather hogues.

He and Edwin went out in the boat, and got some fish; shot a bullock. Kate went on the beach. I went to practice. H. and Mr. W. J. Lane, and Amy have come.

Saturday

August 27th 1870

Fine. Papa rode Dot twice to Mayfield. May and Mrs. M. J. Lane went. He and I pulled a little in the boat first. Amy, and I took the little Dories for a row; then Amy got out Edwin, Kate, & I stayed in a little longer. I. went to practice, & so did J. Mark has been in the sun.

Monday

August 29th 1870

Fine. Papa rode Dot twice to Mayfield. Mark rode Faithful to put some sheep through; then took some to Mayfield. Edwin, Mark, Kate, and I went out

to sea fishing, got two salmon, then
had. Wine to the creek also to picnic.

Tuesday

August 30th 1870

Took horses. Papa rode. Bob, Mrs.
Amy to Mayfield. I rode out in the
sun, then to practice. Kate went to
Marie Park. (Rode by in the sun)
out to Captain Stone. Mama with
back. Edwin drove himself to the May-
day gate.

Wednesday

August 31st 1870

After Baba rode out to Mayfield
Mark went out to the river flats,
rode by to the hills for two sheep. Then
rode. Hittifull in goat sun. Then
rode down to school, and when we
the backs up. Not so much to camp.
I rode to the Post, walked to practice
Guru finished. The working of Mark's
hands all right, went in the boat.

Thursday September 1st 1870

Fine. Papa's birthday, he is fifty eight. rode
twice to Mayfield. He gave Baba a hymn book.
Edwin walked away to go and stay at Mr.
Shaw's. Mark went hunting, got three kangaroos,
one wallaby. Amy rode to the Creek twice.
I drove Mama to the beach (Mayfield), & to see
Anne Webster, who has another boy.

Friday September 2nd 1870

Fine. Baba, Mark, and I rode to Mayfield, got
in the lambs. Kate took a sketch of the
School, and box for me if Gary, to paint in
oils. Amy rode over to Horsell beach.

Saturday September 3rd 1870

Cloudy. Papa rode off twice to Mayfield.

Amy rode there once to help home four cows.
Mark and I rode out to the back run with
sheep, came home through Kati run. Amy
also rode nearly to Gissel, and on the back.
I rode to practice & to the Greek to see James'
planting carrots for Gary. Mark did some
grafting.

Monday September 5th 1870

Been fine. Nipsa rode out to Mayfield twice.
Mark rode once and walked once in the
run. Amy rode ~~out~~ also. Mr. Mayson went
away after breakfast. I cleaned out the boat, &
rode to Horrell's. Kate walked there. It's my walk.

Tuesday September 6th 1870

Been fine. Nipsa and I rode to Swansea.
I walked to the Township twice called on Mr.

H. J. Syne. Jessie Syne came back with Mr.
Shaw and myself.

Wednesday September 7th 1870

Am full and dray. Nipsa and I returned
after dinner. Mr. and Mrs. J. Syne, and Carmichael
were at dinner. Mr. Shaw rode part way with
us. Went down to see the Maysons.

Thursday September 8th 1870

Fair. Mark walked out to the Penny Padd.
Amy rode to the Greek. We have been making
sausages (bacon).

Friday September 9th 1870

Fair day. Nipsa rode out to Mayfield. Mark
walked to the Penny Paddock. rode back to
Kobates. Amy, and I rode to Horrell's. Mark

sold Black on trial, bought a sheepdog
for ten shillings.

Saturday September 10th 1870

Cloudy and windy. Kate went to practice rode
Amy with Amy to Mayfield beach. Mark rode
Faithful to Horsey, went out in the sun. I
planted carrots, went to practice.

Sunday September 12th 1870

Wore fine. Papa rode Dot to Mayfield once.
Mark has had Faithful in the sun. Amy and
I rode to Mayfield beach. I made a house
for the canaries. Kate went to the Post, &
on the beach.

Tuesday September 13th 1870

Fine. Papa rode Dot to Mayfield, did some
gardening. Amy and I rode to Mayfield beach.

Took Astie Dodge for a row, with his mother
and Mr. Watkins because it is his birthday.

I rode down for seaweed before breakfast.

Mark has been grafting at the Fenny Paddock.
Kate went to practice, on the beach.

Wednesday September 14th 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield, went up
gardening. Dr. Geo. Cotton called. Amy rode
to the Middle Paddock before breakfast.

Fine. After dinner. Papa rode to Mayfield twice; up in the garden. Mark has been burning in the Middle paddock; burnt some fence. Amy rode to Mayfield.

Saturday September 17th 1870

Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield twice. Mark has been at the Fancy paddock with James Dapp.

Amy rode down on the beach with me; I rode to practice first. We have been gardening. K. went to practice also.

Monday 18th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Amy and I rode to Mayfield, brought back a cow. Mark has been burning. Mr. Alfred Mayson and Harriet came this evening.

Tuesday September 20th 1870

Tuesday September 21st 1870

Rocky Hills. Kate rode Garry to Horrell. Went
down in the boat with me. Amy had the
lamb turned out.

Thursday September 22nd 1870

Rain this evening. Papa rode twice to
Mayfield twice. Mark burned a little
at Bogues; pruned some trees. Amy has
been poking about. Kate and I went to
the Middle-paddock with her. I went
to the practice. I rode up dinner time

Friday September 23rd 1870

Showy cold. Papa rode twice to Mayfield.

Mark rode Garry to the Middle Paddock, and
to Blans. walked there too. Amy took R. to the
Hedges clearing. Kate and I went down, & build
the boat. One of my Canaries has laid an egg.

Saturday September 24th 1870

Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Mark
has been tramping the hills. Amy and I rode;
to Mayfield, and brought home Jossy and calf.
Amy rode down over the beach, I to practice. I
went in the morning. Iron traps called.

Thursday September 29th 1870

Fine. To Mr. & Mrs. Shaw, Amy, and Nelly Burgess home. State rode to Sustillow after dinner. Mr. Burgess called here. Amy and Nelly went to the township, again with Mr. Shaw, State and I. I went also by myself. Mr. Chapman, and Emily stayed the evening with us.

Friday September 30th 1870

Fine. Hosa I rode to Hulley, she, Mr. & Mrs. Smith returned here with me. After some time Mr. A. Mayson, Miss Dunn, and Harriet came: so Mr. Smith & I rode with them along the Nine-mile beach to the mouth of Swan River & back. Mr. Lyne came part way with us. They all stayed to tea. Little Alice Smith came also. Edmon rode out for some cattle. Gary beat Norma.

Saturday October 1st 1870

Fine. I rode to Green Banks, stayed to tea. Hague and Emily, Mr. Smith & Katie walked to the township with me. Mr. Burgess called yesterday.

Monday October 3rd 1870

Fine yesterday windy today. Edwin and I went to church yesterday, had dinner, and tea at M^r W. J. Lyne's. Mr. & Mrs. Mayson dined there also, so Edwin and M^r Lyne went home with him, to see him and Harriet start for Apsley. Mr.⁴, and I went to meet them but missed them. Mr. and M^r Shaw, Amy, and Nelly came home to dinner. I walked with them to the township. Went out and caught Gary. Mr. John Lyne is here tonight. Edwin built some fence.

Tuesday October 4th 1870

I rode to the Maysons, went a short way with Mr. & Mrs. Mayson, and Emily to Lisdillor. Mr. & M^r W. J. Lyne came here to tea. Doctor Pilgrim dined here. Mr. A. Mayson called. Amy & Nelly bathed. Hannah went to school with Amy.

Thursday October 6th 1870

Windy & warm. Kate rode here today, ^{as far as the} to townships with the Maysons. Mr Mayson called to borrow a horse. Amy, Nelly, & I bathed before breakfast. I went to the Red Gate with them ^{in preparation} Mr Shaw, & Amy went with Kate & me to Mr W. J. Syne's, & I stayed to tea; Mr W. Mayson & Mr L. came back with us part way, Edwin, Mr Fred & Louis Syne met us at the Red Gate. There was a pigeon match today Fred Syne won it.

Friday October 7th 1870

Rain this the ploughing Match day. Margaret, Emily, & Harriet Mayson, came here and stayed until Mr Mayson drove for them. Joseph & Rachel Cotton called. Dr Pilgrim also. Mr

Dove & Miss Dunn came, but we went home first; she went to Mr H. J. Syne's to tea, with Kate, and me. Mr H. J. L. came to Redbanks for us. Mr J. Syne, Fred, & Louis Syne, Lucy Horne, & Miss Mudie came to dinner. We all went to the reading. The rough diamond and "Raining the Wind" were the pieces. Mr J. Syne called at Redbanks.

Saturday October 8th 1870

Beautiful day. Kate, and I are home again. Fred Syne & Edwin came part way with us. Papa rode twice to Mayfield, Amy rode they & I to Houle's. Mr & Mrs. Buckley brought their baby here for the first time. Maria came from Anna Mary, & her brother George returned, he ploughed

at the match. Mark had faithful shot.

Monday October 10th 1870

Cold. — Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Mark rode with some cattle to Lanes took his dinner & went out in the sun. Kate went to Lymes. I rode to practice.

Blowing a hurricane this afternoon. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Mark rode

there for sheep, and out in the sun with Horner. Hatt Horner & I went for a walk. I rode to Mr. Hinshel's for butter & back in half an hour. Amy walked to the creek. We made more potatoe flour. James Dodge has been working for Mama.

Been fine snow on the hills. Papa rode twice to Mayfield. I rode to Mayfield back bridge home with Papa; then down on the beach. Horner & Mark have been out all day. Mr. Wright & Robert brought their things, for they are coming here soon. Kate went down on these peaches. Amy rode to those at Mayfield.

Wednesday July 19th 1871

Snow on the hills - very cold wind.
Papa rode twice to Mayfield. Amy
& I rode to Horne's. Kate rode early
round the middle paddock after we
came back. Mark has been riding
after stragglers all day. Homer took
some potatoes to Mayfield and drove
Tiger cutting shaft.

Thursday July 20th 1871

Been fine. Papa rode to Grayfield.

all day. I rode. Mark has gone for
opossums. Amy went for a ride -
when she came back Kate went.
I rode to Mr. Minshalls for butter.
Two more calves for Jane to feed.

Sunday July 31st 1871

Been fine. Papa dressed sheep.
Mark & Horner went gathering.
I rode to Horrel's. They took sheep
to the saltworks. Took two mobs
to the middle paddock - went

to greet Amy at Mr. Minshalls
who went to Mayfield Beach.

Tuesday August 1st 1871

Sydney.

Thursday November 2nd 1871

Mr^r Hitchens walked to Swansea after breakfast. Mark has been riding about. Homer about sheep also. Amy rode to Mayfield. I rode to the practice, & to Benguite.

Friday November 3rd 1871

Bew fine. Papa rode to Mayfield. Mr H. Linn, drove Hinsdale, Mr Shaw, and Mr^r Hitchens, here to dinner. He & Mrs Linn have returned to Swansea; Amy rode with them. I took some apples to the Hinds, & brought some butter back with me. Mark & Homer gathered the Point suns, & did not come to breakfast until twelve o'clock.

Saturday November 4th 1871

the church ^{at 11 o'clock}. His horse fell & sprained
his ankle, so Mr. Meredith drove him
down to us, and went back again.

Pompey walked to Gedling, & rode
back Papa's horse. Today Mark has
been walking about after sheep.
The Bishop & Mr. Bromby left after
dinner. I packed pears with Pom,
and gooseberries with Amy this evening.

Tuesday November 14th 1871

Cloudy. I drop & go to the school & Bideford bush at Mayfield. Fred & Max went hunting but did not come home. To dinner. Amy went to Mayfield beach. Kate went to practice. Hatty, & I, went there, then to pick gooseberries. Home soon, sunny.

Friday November 17th 1871

Threatened for rain a little. We all went to spend the day at Littlehampton. was sent off time for we were coming, but we made a mistake & told him to come here. But we made ourselves comfortable, went over to Seaford in her boat, & saw Mr. Prache who is dying. All rode but Mark. Home stayed at home to cut chaff. M^r Shaw is here.

Saturday November 18th 1871

Wednesday November 22nd 1871

Commenced to rain this evening.

Mark & Homer got up early, to get sheep in; & have been washing them. Amys', & I, went to Greek garden for strawberries.

Thursday November 23rd 1871

Rained nicely all night, has been snowy the rest of the day. Amys', rode to Mayfield. I rode to the Greek & about for oranges. Mama had a letter from Papa. Mark helped Harris take away the sheepwash yards.

Friday November 24th 1871

Heavy showers. Mark rode out in the rains after dinner & home up hill. Amy, & I rode to Mayfield scrub, buck paddock, & mill. Kate went to the gardens for strawberries. Horel has made a new halter for Garry.

Saturday November 25th 1871

Been threatening for rain. Mark has been out in the rains all day. Amy, & I rode to Mayfield bush to look for sheep - also Holl, & Mr. Marshall, & went to Kenouite for thyme (Amy's)

Monday November 27th 1871

Fine. Mr. Thompson & Harriet came yesterday & my sheep rode away with them today. Amy & I rode to Jessie Valley with them. Mark rode out in rain to Mayfield for sheep. Papa sent our photographs yesterday - five of mine & five of Kate's.

Tuesday November 28th 1871

Heavy shower. Mark, & Horner, got up early & brought home the Mayfield sheep to be sheared today. Amy went for a ride. I rode to Mayfield.

Wednesday November 29th 1871

Fine. Mark & Horner have been sending to the shearers. I rode to Mayfield & told William & George Johnson to shear them. Went to the saltworks. Emma started on

This morning, for horses with the
Bithman. Amy, & I, went to pick pears
in the Greeks garden, I cut some green
stuff for Ben to bring home for Garry.

Thursday November 30th 1871

Fine - Mark & Homer have been in
the barn attending to the shearing.
Sarah & Ellen Lethel came to dinner &
are here still. I rode to Mayfield.

Friday December 1st 1871

Fine - Mark & Homer have been about
the shearing the latter went to Mayfield
the first thing. Sarah, & Ellen, Lethel
went, with Amy, & me to pick pears &
strawberries. They went away about four

o'clock with Samuel Drake who
came to see Mama. Poor Grey slipped
& fell as he was hanging up a sheep, &
the iron hook went through his hand.
He walks about now, & is much fainer.
Mr. & Mrs. Buckley, & little Mary, came here
to tea.

Saturday December 2nd 1871

Fine. Mark & Homer have been about
the sheep shearing. Amy & I picked pears
& cut some stuff for our horses. Called
it from our Garry. Fish got some
fish here.

Sunday December 4th 1871

Very hot wind. Horner rode to Lawrence
the morning with a letter to Pepe. This
afternoon, helped Mark with the sheep.
Mark has been riding Garry. Amy
went to the post. We had Sunday
school yesterday.

Tuesday December 5th 1871

Cloudy, showed by the night. Mark &
Horner have been about the shearing.
Mark brought Rosy's fleece down &
weighed it; it was five pounds & three
quarters. He also branded him. S. Garry
has been shod. "Kestrel" taken the
barb.

Wednesday December 6th 1871

Fine. Marks & Horner have been about
the shearing but they have finished
those washed. Amy and I rode
for peas & strawberries which we
took to her after tea this morning.
Kate got some strawberries. Mr. Arnold
called for an hour; he has Gambria
again. Mark shot a rabbit.

Thursday December 7th 1871

again.

Saturday December 9th 1871

Warm. Mark and Homer have been
sheep washing. I rode to Mr. Hinchalls
with some things for Mr. Price, who

is ill. Then over to look at both hop
grounds. Mr. James Mayson, & Margaret,
went after breakfast.

Sunday December 11th 1871

Fine. Mr. Mayson, came yesterday, went
away after breakfast. Mark rode out in
the sunns. Kate went to the creek gardens
& picked some strawberries for Mr.
Price, which Amy, & I, took to her we
also rode for lollaces. Homer has
been cutting thistles. Amelia, & Emilia,
Puttel, came yesterday & stayed
until this afternoon. Mama took
them to the bazaar. Mr. Blaskey, & W.
Ashley have taken the two boys up, at

at Mayfield Beach Bush, for sheep
shearing.

Tuesday December 12th 1871
Been Monday. Mark has been out the

the shears. Kate, & I, went to pick
strawberries - Amy went with me
for vegetables.

Thursday December 14th 1871
Fine. Papa had the gig mended, to
drive Miss Lope to Red Banks. They
started after dinner. Hattie rode
Dot to drive the gig back. I went to
the practice & to be measured for boots.
Amy rode Garry & led him home to the
Creek for a swim. I saw them
on my way home. She & I went for
vegetables for dinner. Horner & Mark
have been about the shearing.

Friday December 15th 1871

Fine. The shearing is finished. Mark & Horne went to shoot rabbits but got none. Amy's new saddle came by the "Kington" today, so she & I rode to enquire for Mr. Pier this afternoon. I rode for vegetables.

Saturday December 16th 1871

Very warm. Papa drove home today, he bought a new horse at Gambier sale, which State rode home. Amy & I rode to Mayfield - went to pick strawberries. Mark cut part of a beetree down. Horne has been cutting thistles. Fishman came yesterday, & took away Amy's pup & her kitten. Doctor Pilgrim is here & Mr. Owen Meredith, Mr. George W. called.

Monday December 18th 1871

Been fine. Papa, & I rode to Mayfield, & State rode with him this afternoon. Papa likes Joppy very much indeed. Mark has been in the sun all day. Horne cutting thistles. Amy rode to the creek. Dr Pilgrim left after breakfast. Mr. Owen Meredith left early yesterday morning.

Tuesday December 19th 1871

Been fine. Papa paid the hop trainees & rode to Mayfield. Horrel is mending.

Kate's saddle. Mark has been burning.
Homer cutting thistles. Amy, & I, rode
to Mayfield. I rode home along that
beach. Kate, Amy, & I, went for a short
row in the boat. Ben has been watering.

Tednesday December 20th 1871
Fine. Papa rode to Mayfield in the
afternoon. Mark & Homer have been
gathering Kate's run. Mark rode home
in the morning. Kate, Amy, & I, picked
the last of the strawberries, & first
rasberries.

Thursday December 21st 1871
Very warm, thermometer 70 in drawing room.
Mark & Homer about sheep; & took a

pony.
Friday December 22nd 1871
Thermometer 112 in the sun, this morning
but a cool breeze sprung up in ^{the afternoon}.
Papa rode twice to Mayfield. I went
with him this afternoon. Mark, & Homer
gathered Mayfield Sheep; & washed some
straglers - went to take M's bee box at Farny
Baddock.

Saturday December 23rd 1871
Fine. Papa rode twice to Mayfield.
Kate, Amy, and I, went to decorate the
school. Mark has been out all day.
Homer cutting thistles.

Monday Christmas Day 1871
Fine. Mark & Homer helped us decorate

the school we did the house before breakfast. Mark went to Scrub to look at the fire. Kate gave the Sunday School prizes, to the children, & Papa read the lesson. Then started for Swains with Kate, & Amy on their way to the annual picnic at Glengala that is to take place tomorrow. It has Garry Jones, & Sarah sang some hymns at twelve o'clock last night under the my.

Mr Mayson & Emily came yesterday but went away again after tea. Llewellyn Meredithe came to tea on his way home from school, so he went with Mr Mayson.

Tuesday December 26th 1871

Fine. Mark & Homer have been out hunting. I got their breakfasts, & dinners, at six o'clock. Emma & Jane had Dot, & went to see the Ferry Biddock. I boiled gooseberry jam until half past three o'clock, then went to Fels' garden. Mothers & Mary called. Mama went down on the sandbank.

Wednesday December 27th 1871

Fine. Papa, Kate, and Amy, came home this evening. Mark has been toping the Ferry Biddock fence. Sam Drake came for landman's horses cutting thistles. I went for vegetables.

Thursday December 28th 1871

Been fine. Papa rode to Mayfield
& read English news. Mark & got in
the straglers to be shorn. Homer has been
cutting thistles. Kate, Amy, & I, picked
raspberries.

Friday December 29th 1871

Warm but cool wind. I rode to Mayfield
with Papa in the morning, Kate in the

Saturday December 30th 1871

Warm wind, changed in the afternoon to

Papa & Amy rode to Mayfield, I had game.

to Banks' garden. W^m Fox, & W^m Lewis, walked
here dinner-time, enroute for Hobartown.

Monday December January 1st 1872
